

# TS3 Book Challenge



Starting January 5<sup>th</sup>, Township Three students and staff will have the option to participate in a school-wide reading challenge. Students will have a different type of book to read each month, starting in January and finishing in May, completing one book each month.

Students completing the challenge each month will be recognized on the broadcast and their name will be added to the “Book Challenge” wall by the media center. There will also be a celebration at the end of the year for all students completing each month of the challenge.

## Guidelines for the Book Challenge:

- 1) There are a total of five books necessary to complete this challenge. Only the book designated for the current month will qualify for the challenge so students should not try and read all five in one month. Students will read other books of their choice for the remainder of the month.
- 2) The book must be on the student’s AR level. The student will need to complete the book and pass the AR test during the specific month. A reading log will be used for students not required to take AR tests.
- 3) The book can come from home or the public library; it does not have to come from the TS3 library; as long as it is AR and falls into the category for that month. If a book is questionable, please see Ms. Hess to confirm.

JANUARY – a thriller, mystery, or generally creepy book

FEBRUARY – a book with a color word in the title

MARCH – a biography about a person of your choice

APRIL – a book with a nature word in the title (wind, rain, flowers, mountains, animals, etc)

MAY – a book with a place in the title
